On Sep. 21, President Xi Jinping stressed major changes unseen in a century are taking place in our world. The sudden attack of COVID-19 is a grave test for the entire world. Mankind has entered a new era of interconnectedness, with countries sharing intertwined interests and their future closely linked together. Global threats and global challenges require strong, global responses. In the face of new realities and challenges, we must do some serious thinking: What kind of UN is needed for the world? How should the Organization play its role in the post-COVID era?

He put forward four proposals. First, the UN must stand firm for justice. Second, the UN must uphold the rule of law. Third, the UN must promote cooperation. Fourth, the UN must focus on real action.
